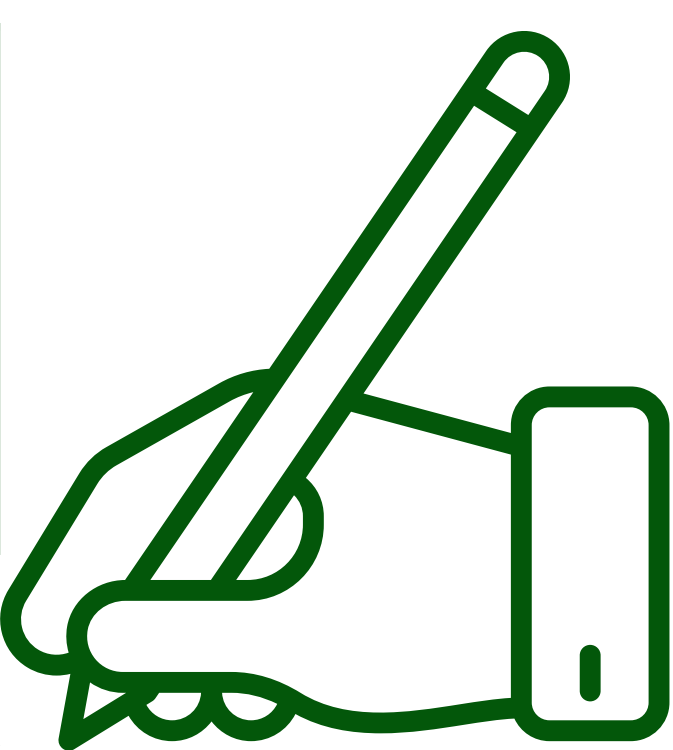
25th May 2026

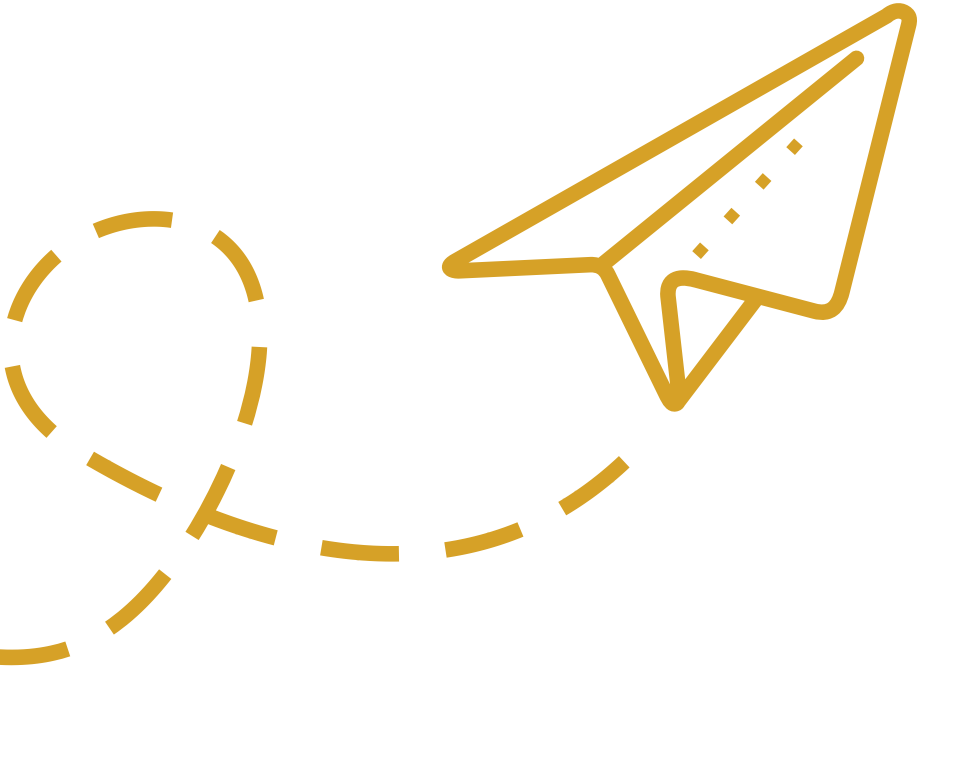

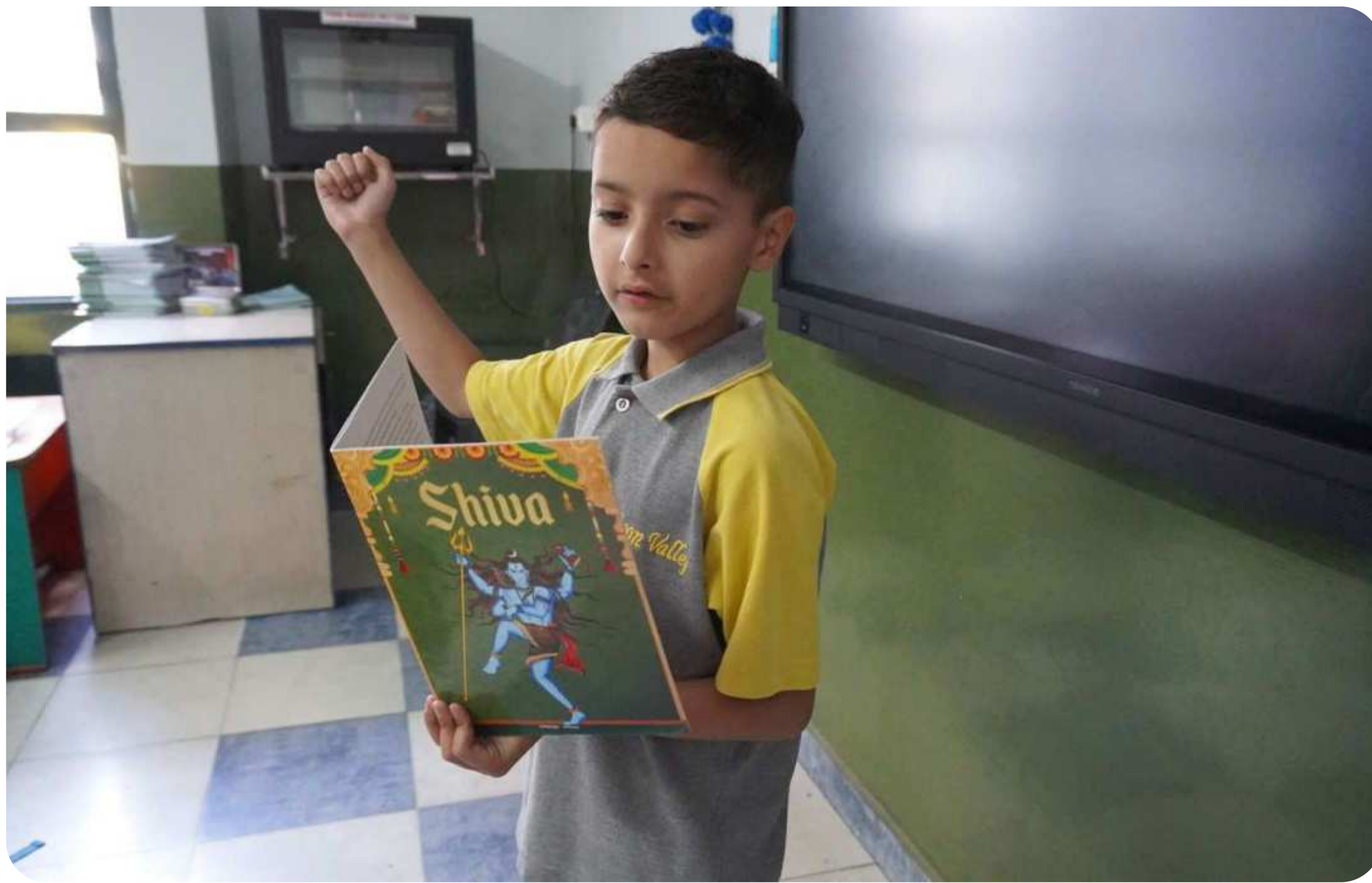
An Inter-House Poster Making Competition titled “Salute to Our Heroes” was organised for Classes IV and V. Students created posters appreciating workers and unsung heroes.

2 Health Awareness Session



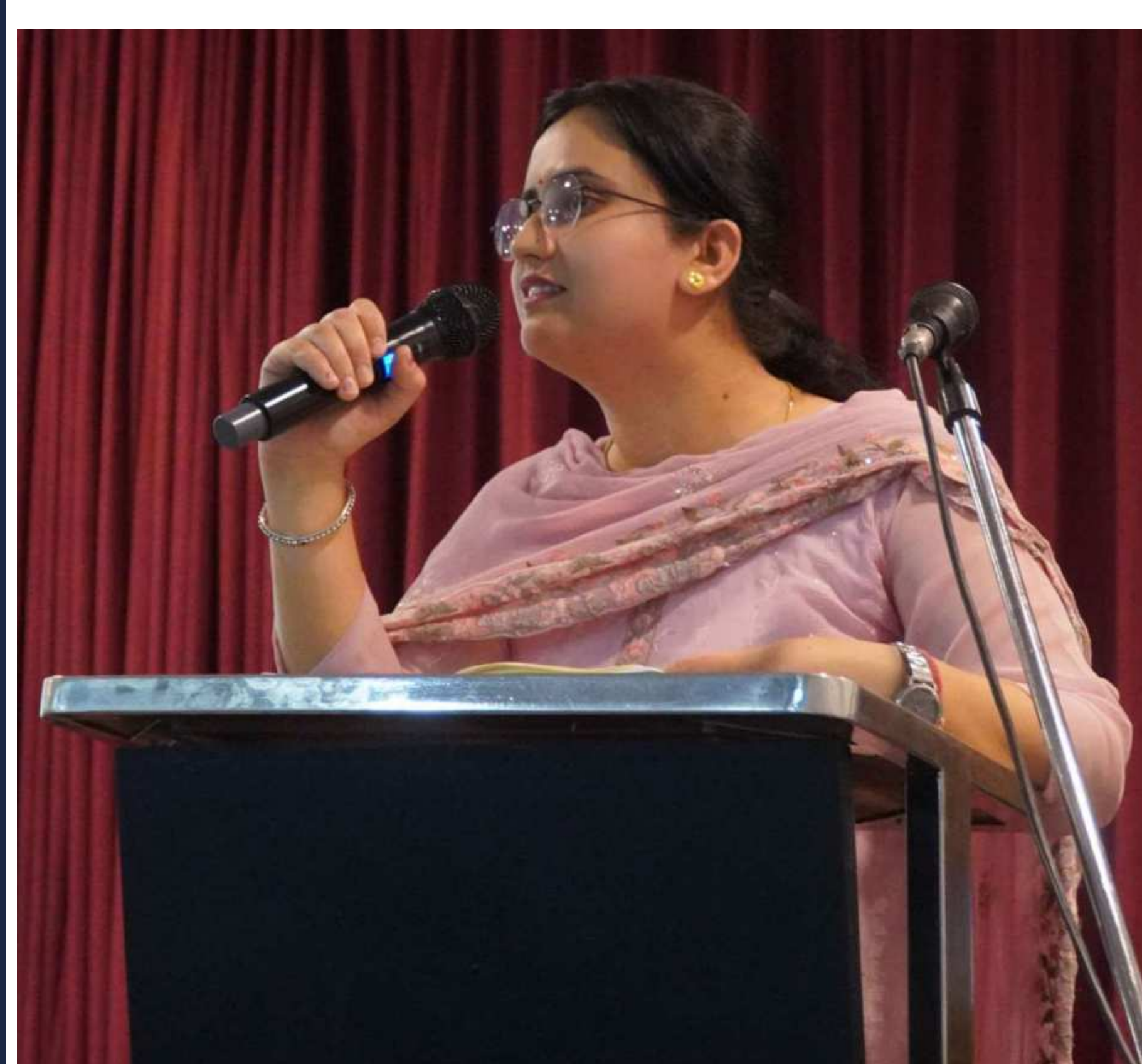

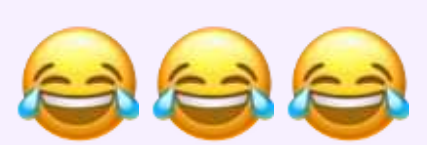

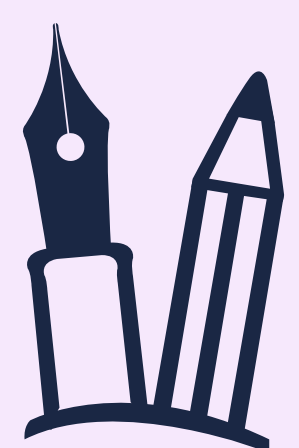
